The following rules have been established by Harmony Horse Stables, LLC to provide a fun, safe environment in the barn for students to learn about horses.



The barn can be a busy place. Always be aware around the horses and listen to the staff. They are there to help you and keep you safe.



Watch where you're going!
Running in the halls can cause accidents.



Please keep your voice down.
Horses can be frightened by loud noises.



A horse's main defense is its hind legs.
If you walk right behind the horse, it might use them!



A staff member's permission is required before opening a stall door or going into a stall.



Always use a halter and cross-ties when working with the horses.



All students must wear long pants and a boot with a heel for riding.



All riders must wear an ASTM safety approved riding helmet when riding.



Please turn your cell phone off before entering the barn or the ring. Cell phones can cause you to be distracted and startle the horse.



There are no silly questions.
Ask a staff member if you are not sure about something.
